followed at 11 a.m. by Native American Dancers. Roger & Randy will be present to entertain at the stage at 12 p.m. and the Retro Rockets will perform there at 1 p.m. At that same time in the park, there there will be Money in the Hay Stack for children.

A Silent Auction will take place beginning at 10:30 a.m. and will close at 3 p.m. Radio KUSN 98.1 of Coffeyville will have a live broadcast from 10 a.m. until noon.

A cow pasture horseshoes tournament will take place north of the park at a cost of \$5 per person. A bake auction will begin at 3 p.m. and you won't want to miss out on all the goodies! Half of the proceeds will go to the Veterans Celebration and the other half to the Flying Frontier 4-H group.

Also, there will be a Car Show by Fastlane and the Christian Motorcycle Club will be present as well as the Montgomery County Smokehouse. The Caney Valley Antique Power Association will also be present with some tractors.

Cross C Ranch will provide a brisket dinner and Art Wade will serve a pork dinner and beans for a freewill donation to the Havana Veterans Celebration.
